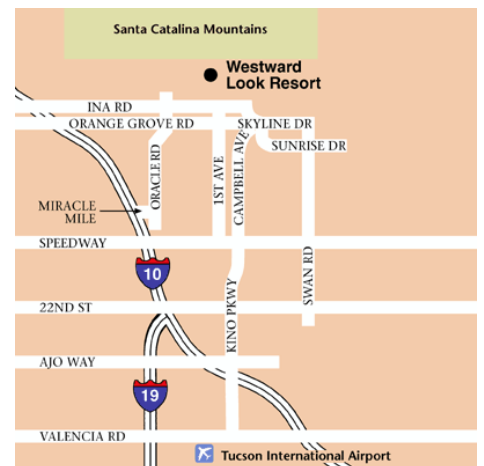
POINTS OF INTEREST

 Exit airport and turn left on Valencia Road heading west for four miles, and exit on to 1-19 North. Head north for a few miles exiting on to 1-10 West. Stay on 1-10 for ten miles to Ina Rd. (Exit #248) turning right on to Ina Rd. Head east on Ina for six miles to Westward Look Drive, turning left at the stoplight. Follow the signs to our beautiful entrance.
